**5. Summary:** Special license plates for immediate family members of persons who have died in military service to their country; fees. Eliminates the one-time \$10 surcharge imposed for issuance of these plates.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Known as Gold Star special license plates, these plates were authorized in 2006. As of October 2007, there were 70 active Gold Star plate registrations. Based on discussions with the Department of Veterans Services (DVS), there is no data on the number of people who are eligible to apply for these plates. Neither DMV nor DVS expect significant increases in demand for the plates.
