- **5. Summary:** Virginia Retirement System; state and local law-enforcement officers. Permits members of the State Police Officers' System, the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System, and local law-enforcement officials covered under the Virginia Retirement System whose localities have elected to provide benefits comparable to that of State Police Officers, to take full retirement (unreduced) if they have at least 25 years of creditable service, regardless of their age.

In addition, the fiscal impact in Item 6 includes the additional cost of the retiree health care credit for members of the State Police Retirement System (SPORS) and Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System (VaLORS).
