3. Committee: Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: **Gang-related criminal information.**

5. Summary: Requires law-enforcement agencies to forward gang-related criminal information to the Department of State Police for inclusion in the annual Crime in Virginia report.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: PRELIMINARY.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: Yes. Item 419

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of State Police, the proposed legislation could have a cost of \$84,080. If changes in the Live Scan and Central Criminal History systems are not required, then the cost could be reduced to \$19,080.

These estimates do not include costs for localities to change their Records Management/Booking systems in order to provide the data.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Local and regional jails statewide, state law enforcement agencies, Department of State Police.
