4. Title: **Virginia Retirement System; average final compensation retirement multiplier for teachers.**

5. Summary: Virginia Retirement System; average final compensation retirement multiplier for teachers. Increases from 1.7 to 2.0 the average final compensation retirement multiplier for teachers with five or more years of creditable service earned as a teacher. The bill applies to current and future retirees.
