**4. Title:** Easement in Staunton River State Park

**5. Summary:** The bill authorizes the Department of Conservation and Recreation to grant a 20-foot wide easement across a portion of Staunton River State Park in exchange for the extinguishment of an existing right-of-way easement.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** The bill does not have a fiscal impact.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** None. The legislation is the result of negotiations between the Department of Conservation and Recreation and the easement holders and represents an agreement by the parties that is believed to be in their joint interests. Approval of the General Assembly and the Governor is required by § 10.1-109, Code of Virginia, to convey interest in real property owned by the Commonwealth, including easements.
