5. Summary: Data Collection; residential service providers. Requires the State Executive Council to develop and implement uniform data collection standards to collect data on residential service providers and residential services provided under the Comprehensive Services Act program and to develop uniform outcome measures to evaluate residential services provided under the Comprehensive Services Act program.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Office of Comprehensive Services is currently working with the State Executive Council to develop and implement uniform data collection standards, therefore the bill has no fiscal impact.

11. Other Comments: The Governor's introduced budget included \$277,000 for the purpose of developing a tool that will assist in the collection and analysis of such data as required by this bill.
