**4. Title:**         **Comprehensive Services Act; data collection.**

**5. Summary:** Requires the Office of Comprehensive Services to include in its child-level data set a field (i) identifying the facility in which a child receives services, including any residential service provider's identification number, (ii) indicating the circumstances under which each child ends each service, and (iii) indicating the circumstances under which each child exits the Comprehensive Services Act program.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** None

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Office of Comprehensive Services is currently working with the State Executive Council and localities to develop, implement and improve uniform data collection standards, therefore the bill has no fiscal impact.

**11. Other Comments:** The Governor's introduced budget included \$277,000 for the purpose of developing a tool that will assist in the collection and analysis of such data as required by this bill.
