**5. Summary:** Elections; paper and electronic pollbooks. Permits localities to use their own funds to purchase electronic pollbooks that have been approved by the State Board of Elections. Current law authorizes the use of electronic pollbooks only in pilot programs and when paid for by state appropriations.

#### 8. Fiscal Implications:

Wireless exception for transmitting results is not anticipated to produce immediate cost savings for the State Board of Elections. The above savings estimate is based on statewide use of electronic pollbooks. Savings would likely not be realized for the State Board of Elections prior to FY 2010 due to time necessary for statewide deployment of pollbooks.

# State Board of Elections Cost Savings

The benefit in transmitting results via wireless communication would be immediate efficiency at the local level. This would be the case when a locality has purchased voting equipment technology that allows them to transmit the results directly from the voting equipment located at the precinct to the registrar's office or another central location. Transmission via wireless technology would eliminate the need for land lines in the polling place area.
