3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Urban archery season.

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to adopt regulations for the special archery season that include provisions for daily hunting.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See item 8, below.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation adds another day to the season's weeks. To enforce the provisions of the legislation, the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries could hire additional wardens or authorize overtime, or redeploy the agency's current warden staff. Any fiscal impact is expected to be minimal.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Game and Inland Fisheries.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: SB524 provides for hunting on Sunday. That bill is also before the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources.
