11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 23-9.6:3 as follows:
13	§ 23-9.6:3. Nonstock corporation to assist academic research; reports; special fund created.
14	A. The Council shall establish a nonprofit, nonstock corporation under Chapter 10 (§ 13.1-801 et
15	seq.) of Title 13.1 as a public instrumentality exercising public and essential governmental functions to
16	assist the Council in (i) supporting academic research in Virginia; (ii) encouraging research initiatives,
17	with emphasis on biological systems and nanotechnology, to support Virginia industry; (iii) directing the
18	disbursement of funds for such research initiatives based on established scientific criteria from the
19	Academic Research Initiative Fund created pursuant to subsection C; and (iv) conducting or
20	undertaking other activities useful in carrying out the provisions of this section. The corporation may do
21	business as the "Virginia Academic Research Corporation." Such corporation shall report to the Council
22	at least annually on its activities.
23	The board of directors of such corporation shall be composed of 13 members as follows: the
24 25	Director of the Council, the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, the Secretary of Technology, four members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, two members appointed by the Senate
25 26	Committee on Rules, and four members appointed by the Governor. Members appointed by the
27 27	Governor shall serve five-year terms. The board of directors shall appoint a scientific advisory
28	committee to review funding proposals for scientific viability and may appoint such other advisory
29	committees as it deems appropriate to assist it in the performance of its mission.
30	B. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Virginia Academic Research Corporation (the
31	Corporation) shall provide to the Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance
32	Committees and the Director of the Department of Planning and Budget a report of its operating plan.
33	Prior to September 1 of each fiscal year, the Corporation shall provide to the Chairmen of the House
34	Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees and the Director of the Department of Planning and
35	Budget a detailed expenditure report and a listing of the salaries and bonuses for all employees of the
36	Corporation for the prior fiscal year. All such reports shall be prepared in the formats previously
37	approved by the Department of Planning and Budget.
38 39	C. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the Academic Research Initiative Fund (the Fund). The Fund shall be established on the books of the
39 40	Comptroller. Any funds appropriated to it by the general appropriation act and revenue from any other
4 0 4 1	source, public or private, shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the Fund. Interest earned
42	on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the
43	Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund but
44	shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used by the Corporation solely for the purposes
45	of supporting academic research in Virginia and encouraging research initiatives, with emphasis on
46	biological systems and nanotechnology, to support Virginia industry. Expenditures and disbursements
47	from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the Comptroller upon written
48	request signed by the chairman of the board of directors of the Corporation.
