6 WHEREAS, Audrey Harris of Richmond is commended for receiving the 2008 Outstanding 7 Individual American Lawyers Auxiliary Volunteer Award; and

8 WHEREAS, the Outstanding Individual American Lawyers Auxiliary Volunteer Award is given 9 annually to a member who most effectively increases member and public understanding of the law and 10 the American legal system; and

WHEREAS, a hard-working and committed volunteer, Audrey Harris has been a member of the 11 Richmond Lawyers Auxiliary since its founding in 1973 and has served as recording secretary, vice 12 13 president, and president of the organization; and

WHEREAS, in the mid-1980s, Audrey Harris, recognized for her organizational and administrative 14 15 ability, was appointed by Virginia Supreme Court Chief Justice Harry Carrico as the Chairman of the 16 Carrico Commission on Law-Related Education; and

WHEREAS, the task of the Commission was to encourage court tours for young people throughout 17 the Commonwealth; Audrey Harris created a 107-page booklet for schools and auxiliaries to use in 18 19 conjunction with the court tours program in Virginia; and

20 WHEREAS, Audrey Harris organized the First Task Force for the Richmond Lawyers Auxiliary for 21 the Court Docent Program, which began in the City of Richmond schools in 1980, with Henrico County 22 schools later joining; and

23 WHEREAS, Audrey Harris continues to serve as a court docent for the City of Richmond School 24 Program, which provides an opportunity for middle school students to meet members of the judicial 25 system, tour the courthouse and jail, and learn more about the judicial system; and

WHEREAS, Audrey Harris has generously given of her time and talents over the years to help 26 27 educate the young people of Virginia on the legal and judicial systems of the Commonwealth; and

28 WHEREAS, Audrey Harris is actively involved at River Road Church, Baptist and received the 1995 29 Alumni Medallion from The College of William and Mary; now, therefore, be it

30 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend Audrey Harris on receiving the 2008 Outstanding Individual American Lawyers Auxiliary 31 32 Volunteer Award; and, be it

33 RESOLVED FURTHER. That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 34 for presentation to Audrey Harris as an expression of the General Assembly's congratulations on her 35 well-deserved honor.
