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## **SENATE BILL NO. 817**

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the House Committee on Transportation

on February 19, 2009)

4 5 6 7 A BILL to authorize the issuance of special license plates promoting tourism and conservation on the Northern Neck, for supporters of the Shenandoah National Park Trust, and for supporters of the 8 9 Choose Life Virginia Fund, and to repeal § 46.2-749.49:1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to special 10 license plates for supporters of the Shenandoah National Park Association.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

**1.** § 1. Special license plates promoting tourism and conservation on the Northern Neck; fees. 12

13 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, and following the 14 provisions of § 46.2-725 of the Code of Virginia other than those relating to the fee for the plates and 15 its disposition, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles shall issue to the applicant 16 special license plates promoting tourism and conservation on the Northern Neck.

17 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to 18 19 this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known 20 as the Northern Neck Land Conservancy Fund established within the Department of Accounts. These 21 funds shall be paid annually to the Northern Neck Land Conservancy and used to support its operation 22 and programs. All other fees imposed under the provisions of this section shall be paid to, and received 23 by, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles, and paid by him into the state treasury and 24 set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the necessary expenses incurred by the Department of 25 Motor Vehicles. 26

§ 2. Special license plates for supporters of the Shenandoah National Park Trust; fees.

27 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, and following the 28 provisions of § 46.2-725 of the Code of Virginia other than those relating to the fee for the plates and 29 its disposition, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles shall issue special license plates 30 to and supporters of the Shenandoah National Park Trust.

31 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed 32 fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to 33 this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known 34 as the Shenandoah National Park Trust Fund established within the Department of Accounts. These 35 funds shall be paid annually to the Shenandoah National Park Trust and used to support its activities 36 and programs in the Commonwealth. All other fees imposed under the provisions of this section shall be 37 paid to, and received by, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles, and paid by him into 38 the state treasury and set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the necessary expenses incurred by 39 the Department of Motor Vehicles. 40

§ 3. Special license plates for supporters of the Choose Life Virginia Fund; fees.

41 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, and following the 42 provisions of § 46.2-725 of the Code of Virginia other than those relating to the fee for the license plates and its disposition, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles shall issue special 43 license plates bearing the legend CHOOSE LIFE to supporters of the Choose Life Virginia Fund, 44 45 prescribed in subsection B.

B. The annual fee for license plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the 46 47 prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting **48** fund known as the Choose Life Virginia Fund established within the Department of Accounts. These 49 50 funds shall be paid annually to Heartbeat International, Inc., to be distributed in equal grants to pregnancy center locations in Virginia that are tax exempt organizations under § 501 (c) (3) of the 51 Internal Revenue Code and officially committed to Heartbeat International's "Our Commitment of Care" 52 53 standards. Choose Life Virginia Fund distributed funds are to be used to provide services to pregnant 54 women and women who suspect that they may be pregnant in Virginia and may be refused within 60 days by return to the Choose Life Virginia Fund. The Commissioner shall provide annually to Heartbeat 55 International, Inc., a summary report for the annual reporting period containing (i) Choose Life 56 Virginia initial plate issuances and renewals (both counts and dollars) and (ii) the return address to be 57 used if a pregnancy center location wishes to refuse to receive Choose Life Virginia funds. All other 58 59 fees imposed under the provisions of this section shall be paid to, and received by, the Commissioner of

- the Department of Motor Vehicles, and paid by him into the state treasury and set aside as a special 60
- fund to be used to meet the necessary expenses incurred by the Department of Motor Vehicles. 2. That § 46.2-749.49:1 of the Code of Virginia is repealed. 61
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- 3. That, notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this act, special license plates issued to supporters of the Shenandoah National Park Association pursuant to § 46.2-749.49:1 of the Code 63
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- of Virginia prior to July 1, 2009, shall remain valid until their expiration date, but shall be 65
- 66 renewed thereafter under the provisions of subsection B of § 2 of this act.
