096681332 **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 340** 1 2 Offered January 14, 2009 3 Prefiled January 13, 2009 4 Commending the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants on the occasion of its 100th 5 anniversary. 6 Patrons-Stosch; Delegates: Crockett-Stark and Massie 7 8 WHEREAS, the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants will celebrate its 100th anniversary 9 in 2009 as the leading professional association for Virginia Certified Public Accountants; and WHEREAS, the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants was founded on October 6, 1909, 10 with 19 charter members and now represents more than 8,300 certified public accountants (CPAs) 11 working in private businesses, government agencies, nonprofit organizations, educational institutions, and 12 public accounting firms of all sizes; and 13 WHEREAS, the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants has 10 chapters across the 14 15 Commonwealth that offer networking, education, and opportunities to get involved in local communities; 16 and WHEREAS, the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants aims to enhance the success of 17 18 CPAs by serving as a central source of information for its members; offering professional education 19 programs; representing CPAs before state and federal regulators and legislators; and promoting the 20 image of the CPA with the general public, media, legislators, educators, and students; and 21 WHEREAS, the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants has an award-winning Financial 22 Fitness Initiative and other community outreach programs in which thousands of licensed CPAs provide 23 pro bono services to educate and assist the public on personal finance and money management issues; 24 and 25 WHEREAS, the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants formed the CPA Political Action 26 Committee of Virginia in 1981 to raise funds and financially assist political candidates and legislators 27 who support interests of the CPA profession; and 28 WHEREAS, the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants created an Educational Foundation 29 in 1984 to attract future CPAs and promote accounting careers to Virginia students through 30 undergraduate and graduate scholarships, financial literacy grants, and other awards and recognition 31 programs; and 32 WHEREAS, CPAs play a unique and vital role in the success and growth of business, the soundness 33 of government operations, the excellence of higher education, and the protection and confidence of investors in the Commonwealth of Virginia and throughout the United States of America; and 34 35 WHEREAS, the Virginia General Assembly passed the Accountancy Bill in 1910, introduced by the 36 Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants, to form the regulatory body called the Virginia Board 37 of Accountancy to oversee the examination and certification of accountants in Virginia; and WHEREAS, the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants has a long and rich history, with 38 39 remarkable growth and success since 1909, and continues to enrich the lives of CPAs and the citizenry 40 of the Commonwealth through innovation, advocacy, and professional services; now, therefore, be it 41 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly commend and congratulate the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants on the occasion of its 42 100th anniversary; and, be it 43 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for 44 presentation to the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants as an expression of the General 45 Assembly's gratitude to the organization's commitment to its members and the citizens of Virginia and 46 best wishes for continued success in the future. 47
