5 6 WHEREAS, the Honorable Wade St. Clair Coates of Tazewell, esteemed citizen of the 7 Commonwealth and longtime General District Court judge for the 29th Judicial District of Virginia, died 8 on November 19, 2008; and

9 WHEREAS, born on June 8, 1919, the son of the late Thomas Felix Coates and Ella Wooding Carter 10 Coates, Wade St. Clair Coates received his undergraduate degree from Bluefield College and earned his law degree from T. C. Williams School of Law at the University of Richmond; and 11

WHEREAS, while at law school, World War II erupted and Wade St. Clair Coates enlisted and 12 honorably served his country in the United States Army Air Corps; and 13

14 WHEREAS, after his military service, Wade St. Clair Coates finished law school and joined the John 15 Boggess law firm in Tazewell; and

WHEREAS, Wade St. Clair Coates married Virginia Johnson and the couple had three wonderful 16 daughters, Elizabeth "Betty," Katherine, and Anne; and 17

- WHEREAS, Wade St. Clair Coates was elected Commonwealth's attorney in 1955 and served until 18 19 being appointed to the bench in 1977 as judge of the General District Court for the 29th Judicial 20 District: and
- 21 WHEREAS, Judge Coates retired as a full-time judge in 1984, but continued to serve his fellow 22 citizens of Tazewell as a substitute judge for many years; and
- 23 WHEREAS, throughout his time on the bench, Judge Coates served all the citizens of the 24 Commonwealth, in matters great and small, with his unique blend of humor, intellect, common sense, 25 and commitment to equal justice for all; and
- WHEREAS, throughout his life and career, Judge Coates gave generously of his time and immense 26 27 talents to many civic organizations, including as a charter member of the Tazewell County Sportsman 28 Club in Burkes Garden, as a member of the Tazewell American Legion and the Tazewell Lions Club, 29 and as a Paul Harris Fellow of the Tazewell Rotary Club; and

30 WHEREAS, Judge Coates was a faithful member of the Stras Memorial Episcopal Church in 31 Tazewell and active in the church's many missions in the community; and

32 WHEREAS, Judge Coates loved the outdoors, was an avid fisherman and gardener, and loved to 33 share what he grew, especially his pumpkins; and

WHEREAS, Judge Coates will be fondly remembered for his kind and generous nature and greatly 34 35 missed by his daughters, their families, including his two grandchildren and step-granddaughter; his 36 numerous other loving family members, colleagues, and friends; and the citizens of the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it 37

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 38 39 note with great sadness the passing of a fine jurist and outstanding Virginian, the Honorable Wade St. 40 Clair Coates; and, be it
