4. Title: U.S. Route 58 Business - "Holland-Councill Memorial Bridge," Isle of Wight County

5. Summary/Purpose:

To designate the U.S. Route 58 Business bridge over the Blackwater River in Isle of Wight County the "Holland-Councill Memorial Bridge."

6. No Fiscal Impact

7. Budget amendment necessary: NO

8. Fiscal implications: Although VDOT will incur initial costs, the County will reimburse VDOT costs after the signs are placed. §33.1-12(4) and §33.1-250 of the Code of Virginia require the governing bodies in the vicinity of named structures to concur and the locality in which the structure is located to agree to sustain the costs VDOT incurs in the provision and erection of commemorative naming signs. VDOT estimates the costs to be \$400 per sign. The Town of Franklin is involved as it is within the mileage range in which concurrence of a neighboring jurisdiction is necessary.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: VDOT, Isle of Wight, Town of Franklin

11. Other comments: This is the companion bill to SB 802, which was reported from the House Transportation Committee on February 17, 2009 in a unanimous vote . SB 802 is identical to HB 1713.
