- **5. Summary:** Local deferred compensation plans. Permits a locality to provide for automatic enrollment of all employees in a deferred compensation plan.

- **9.** Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: As currently written, the bill does not affect VRS or participating employers.
- 10. Technical Amendment Necessary: Yes
- **11. Other Comments:** As written, the proposed change applies only to subdivisions that administer their own 457 plans. Section 51.1-603.1 could be amended to allow political subdivisions that participate in the Commonwealth's 457 Plan to elect the auto enrollment feature.

As introduced, this legislation does not provide for a negative election by which employees may decline participation. In plans with an automatic contribution arrangement, a negative election is required under the federal Pension Protection Act.
