5. Summary/Purpose:

Current state law requires that, before being constructed or expanded, any hospital or similar medical care facility, receive a certificate of public need from the Board of Health. The proposed legislation would exempt any facility of the Department of Corrections from this requirement.

6. Fiscal Impact: Preliminary. See Item 8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: None.

8. Fiscal implications:

If the Department of Corrections were to construct a hospital or medical facility covered by the certificate of public need provisions, securing a certificate of public need could be time-consuming and expensive. It would be an unnecessary expense because the General Assembly would have, in effect, declared the need for the facility when it authorized its construction.
