4. **Title:**            **Motorcycles; issuance by DMV certain classifications.**

5. **Summary:** This bill provides for issuance by the Department of Motor Vehicles of motorcycle classifications by mail to holders of Virginia driver's licenses if they are U.S. Armed Services members stationed outside Virginia, their spouses, or their dependents, if they can show proof of successful completion of a basic motorcycle rider course approved by the U.S. Armed Services and of their assignment outside Virginia.

8. **Fiscal implications:** This bill is likely to have limited fiscal impact on the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). The expenditure impact above reflects the cost for changes to DMV's automated system to support the provisions of this bill. Minimal staff impact is expected. Though the number of people who will take advantage of the provisions of this bill cannot be determined, it is expected to be small. DMV expects negligible revenue impact.

During the multi-year transition period to Real ID-compliant licenses, DMV would not be able to issue the motorcycle classifications under this bill for pre-Real ID driver's licenses in a Real ID license format. Provisions would need to be made for DMV to issue non-Real ID-compliant driver's licenses during this time period.
