4. Title: **Line of Duty Act; claim for payment; costs.**

5. Summary: Exempts police departments and sheriff's offices from the requirement to reimburse the costs for investigations conducted by the Department of State Police regarding claims for payment under the Line of Duty Act.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: *Indeterminate.*

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of State Police, the fiscal impact due to this legislation cannot be determined at this time. The department stated that it is not able to determine the number of investigations that would result if this legislation passes. However, the department was able to estimate the cost of each death investigation (\$1,563) and each injury investigation (\$1,049).
