4. Title: **Certification of stormwater development property**

5. Summary: The bill authorizes the Department of Conservation and Recreation to certify stormwater management development properties as being designed, constructed, or reconstructed for the primary purpose of abating or preventing pollution. Such a certification allows the local government to tax the property at a different rate from other classifications of real property. This technical change is necessary because responsibility for administering the stormwater program was moved from the Department of Environmental Quality to the Department of Conservation and Recreation.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill does not have a fiscal impact.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill changes the Code of Virginia to reflect the program transfer from the Department of Environmental Quality to the Department of Conservation and Recreation. The associated resources have already been transferred.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Environmental Quality, Department of Conservation and Recreation.
