4. Title: **Onsite treatment works designs incorporating soilbase disposal or treatment component; include report of professional soil scientist**

5. Summary: Provides that designs for onsite treatment works submitted to the Department of Health shall include a report prepared by a Virginia certified professional soil scientist, where the plan includes utilization of a soilbase disposal or treatment component.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Health and the Board of Health
