5.	<b>Summary:</b> The bill authorizes permit-issuing authorities to allow stormwater permit holders to comply with nonpoint nutrient runoff water quality criteria by acquiring offsite nonpoint nutrient offsets that have been certified under the Chesapeake Bay Nutrient Exchange Program. The credit offsets have to be (i) in the same tributary and (ii) included in a permitissuing authority's regional stormwater management plan. The bill also requires an offset broker to pay the permit-issuing authority a fee equal to six percent of the amount paid by the permittee for the offsets.
6.	Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See item 8.

8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> The bill requires a nonpoint source pollution offset broker to pay a water quality enhancement fee of six percent of the amount paid for the offsets to the local permitting authority. If there is no local program, then the payment is deposited to the Virginia Stormwater Management Fund. The fee revenue and cost of developing the offset program cannot be determined at this time.
