Summary: The proposed legislation removes requirement that a prescriber obtain written consent from the recipient of a prescription before requesting information on that recipient for the purpose of establishing his treatment history. However, requires that notice be given to patients that information may be requested by the prescriber from the Prescription Monitoring Program.
