**4. Title:** Arrest of Illegal Immigrants

**5. Summary:** Removes Code provision that prohibits an arrest of an illegal alien (who has been previously convicted of a felony and deported) more frequently than once every six months.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate (see Item 8)

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation would allow an illegal alien who had been previously convicted of a felony and deported to be arrested more than once every 6 months. According to the Supreme Court of Virginia, this legislation would likely cause an increase in the number of hearings however it is not known how many additional cases would be generated. The number of additional hearings is assumed to be small and should be able to be accommodated utilizing current court resources.

According to the Compensation Board, the jail association foresees no material fiscal impact based on the legislation, as introduced.
