4. Title: **Lynchburg Criminal Justice Training Academy; allowed to train private correctional personnel**

Summary: Allows the Lynchburg Criminal Justice Training Academy to enter into an agreement to train private correctional personnel employed by the Immigration Centers of America-Farmville, so long as such agreement provides for the reimbursement of the costs of such training. The bill contains an emergency clause.
