**4. Title:** Wastewater treatment plants; total maximum daily load allocations

**5. Summary:** The bill allows petitions from facilities to extend the deadline for waste load allocations no later than December 31, 2015.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** None.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Department of Environmental Quality, State Water Control Board.

**11. Other Comments:** The second enactment clause exempts regulation amendments pursuant to this act from Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act. The third enactment clause states that the act shall not prohibit any person from petitioning the State Water Control Board to amend existing nutrient waste load allocations.
