- 11. Other Comments: The Comprehensive Services Act (CSA) provides localities wide latitude in how they conduct their CSA. In keeping with this authority, localities across the Commonwealth have developed, adopted and in many cases modified over time their multidisciplinary team planning processes.

The OCS, in collaboration with local governments, can develop and distribute guidelines for local consideration in developing their local multidisciplinary team service planning process. While this bill would statutorily specify explicitly this task, the current statute already provides authority for this activity.
