**3. Committee:** Courts of Justice

**4. Title:** Juvenile dispositions.

**5. Summary:** Allows juveniles who have previously been adjudicated delinquent of a violent juvenile felony to be confined in a detention home or other secure juvenile facility. The bill also requires the court to consider the assessment completed by the secure facility regarding the appropriateness of the placement when ordering a period of confinement that exceeds 30 days.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Juvenile Justice does not expect a fiscal impact due to this legislation. The department stated that there might be a fiscal impact on some localities. This potential impact has not been determined at this time.
