4. Title: Land exchange

5. Summary: The bill authorizes an exchange of parcels of land between the Department of Conservation and Recreation and the Department of Forestry. The Department of Conservation and Recreation will swap a tract in or adjacent to Grayson Highlands State Park in Grayson County with parcel owned by the Department of Forestry which adjoins Holliday Lake State Park (Appomattox County). Section 10.1-109, Code of Virginia, requires General Assembly approval prior to the conveyance of lands owned by the Department of Conservation and Recreation.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: The bill does not have a fiscal impact. See item 8.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The costs associated with the property conveyance (surveying, title searches etc.) will be absorbed by the departments.
