- 5. Summary: The substitute bill authorizes an exchange of parcels of land between the Department of Conservation and Recreation and the Department of Forestry. The Department of Conservation and Recreation will swap a tract in or adjacent to Grayson Highlands State Park in Grayson County with parcel owned by the Department of Forestry which adjoins Holliday Lake State Park (Appomattox County). Section 10.1-109, Code of Virginia, requires General Assembly approval prior to the conveyance of lands owned by the Department of Conservation and Recreation.
- **6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** The bill does not have a fiscal impact. See item 8.
- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The costs associated with the property conveyance (surveying, title searches etc.) will be absorbed by the departments.
- **9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Department of Conservation and Recreation, Department of Forestry.
- **10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** Yes, line 14, strike "Commissioner" and insert "Director."
- **11. Other Comments:** The substitute bill eliminates reference to the amount of acreage to be exchanged.
