**4. Title:** Children in need of supervision or services.

**5. Summary:** Creates an article entitled “Children in Need of Supervision or Services” into which certain existing statutory provisions relating to intake, violations of court orders, and the criteria for detention or shelter care are either moved or duplicated.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Minimal

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill reorganizes all sections of the juvenile code dealing with children in need of services and supervision, including petitions, orders, dispositions, and violations of court orders. There may be minimal costs to the Department of Juvenile Justice to make changes to the Juvenile Tracking System where code sections are cited, however existing staff could be used to make system updates.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Department of Juvenile Justice, Courts.
