4. Title: Designates area agencies on agency as lead for the No Wrong Door initiative

5. Summary: The bill provides that each area agency on aging is the lead agency in their respective areas for the No Wrong Door initiative. The purpose of the initiative is to develop a one-stop for adult health and human services. The idea is to ultimately have resource centers in every community serving as highly visible and trusted places where individuals can turn for information on the full range of long-term support options and entry to public long-term support programs and benefits. Local advisory councils led by local area agencies on aging coordinate the No Wrong Door initiative.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill has no fiscal impact because this bill simply codifies existing language in the 2008 Appropriation Act (Chapter 879, 2008 Acts of Assembly) in item 284, paragraph N , which designates local area agencies as the lead agency in each respective area for the No Wrong Door initiative.
