3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Department of Forestry permit.

5. Summary: Authorizes the State Forester to require a person to obtain a permit to fish, ride a mountain bike, or ride a horse on lands under the control of the Department of Forestry. Currently, the Department requires a permit to hunt or trap on such lands.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are indeterminate. See item 8, below.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact will depend on the number of additional permits issued by the Department of Forestry and the amount of the permit fee. The proposed legislation may have a nongeneral fund revenue impact; however, at this time any impact is indeterminate.
