- **8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation broadens the range of topics covered by the family life education curriculum in grades K through 12 to include instruction on the values and benefits of marriage for men, women, children, and communities. The bill does not define the values and benefits to be incorporated into the curriculum making it difficult to ascertain any potential costs resulting from its passage. If curriculum changes are required, there would be some administrative costs associated with the development and passage of new family life education guidelines by the Board of Education. In addition, there could be additional costs associated with the procurement of new instructional materials that include information on the values and benefits of marriage based on the revised guidelines. Given the extent of any curriculum changes is unknown at this time, it is not possible to reliably estimate the potential cost of this legislation.
