# 5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill would require that upon the written request of the local Commissioner of the Revenue, every property owners' association, condominium unit owners' association, and proprietary lessees' association provide to the Commissioner of the Revenue a list of the owners of property it manages, to the extent it maintains such a list. Additionally, the bill would require that upon the written request of the local Commissioner of the Revenue, owners or operators of self-service storage facilities file with the Commissioner of the Revenue on or before February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, a list giving the name and address of every tenant renting the common area space of the storage facility as of the preceding January 1<sup>st</sup>.

Under current law, owners or operators of apartment houses, office buildings, shopping centers, trailer camps, trailer courts, marinas, or privately owned airports in Virginia are required, upon written request, to file with the local commissioner of the revenue a list giving the name and address of every tenant of such building for use in administering the local property taxes.

The effective date of this bill is not specified.

### 8. Fiscal implications:

This bill would have no impact on state revenues. This bill would have an unknown positive impact on local revenues to the extent that localities are able to assess additional local taxes based on the information provided by the property owners', condominium unit owners', and proprietary lessees' associations, and by owners of self-storage facilities.

#### 11. Other comments:

### **Current Law**

Current law requires that, upon written request of the Commissioner of the Revenue, every person owning or operating an apartment house, office building, shopping center, trailer camp, trailer court, marina, or privately owned or operated airport in Virginia file with the Commissioner of the Revenue a list that provides the name and address of every tenant of these properties as of January 1. The owners or operators must provide such list to the Commissioner of the Revenue on or before February 1<sup>st</sup> of every year.

# **Proposal**

This bill would require that upon the written request of the local Commissioner of the Revenue, every property owners' association, condominium unit owners' association, and proprietary lessees' association provide to the Commissioner of the Revenue a list of the owners of property it manages, to the extent it maintains such a list. Additionally, the bill would require that upon the written request of the local Commissioner of the Revenue, owners or operators of self-service storage facilities file with the Commissioner of the Revenue on or before February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, a list giving the name and address of every tenant renting the common area space of the storage facility for the storage of tangible personal property as of the preceding January 1<sup>st</sup>.

The effective date of this bill is not specified.

# Similar Legislation

**House Bill 2289** is identical to this bill, but the provisions requiring storage facility owners to provide lists of renters of such facilities is applicable only to owners that make the <u>outdoor</u> common area of the facility available for storage of tangible personal property.
