HOUSE BILL NO. 1033

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Joint Conference Committee  
on March 13, 2010)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Byron)

A *BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-32.3, relating to human infant; independent and separate existence.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-32.3 as follows:**

*§ 18.2-32.3. Human infant; independent and separate existence.*

*For the purposes of this article, the fact that the umbilical cord has not been cut or that the placenta remains attached shall not be considered in determining whether a human infant has achieved an independent and separate existence.*

**2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \_\_\_\_\_ for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 781 of the Acts of Assembly of 2009 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \_\_\_\_\_ for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.**
