That § 38.2-3541.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 38.2-3541.1. Continuation following involuntary termination of employment; special circumstances. 12 A. For purposes of meeting the definition of "COBRA continuation coverage" in Title III of Division 13 B of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, P.L. 111-5 (the Act), employees who are 14 15 involuntarily terminated during the period beginning September 1, 2008, and ending December 31, 2009, or during any period for which premium assistance is specified by the Act as later amended, shall be 16 offered the option to continue their existing group health insurance coverage subject to the following: 17 1. Coverage shall continue for a period of up to nine months, or any additional period specified by 18 19 the Act as later amended, following the date of (i) involuntary termination for those terminated on or 20 after the date of enactment of this section or (ii) following the date of the notification required pursuant 21 to subdivision 3, contingent upon the involuntarily terminated employee's eligibility for premium 22 assistance under the Act; 23 2. Premium payments (i) may be paid on a monthly basis to the group policyholder and (ii) shall not 24 exceed 102 percent of the insurer's current premium rate applicable to the group policy; 25 3. Employers shall provide notification of the availability of continuation under this section as 26 follows: 27 a. Notification shall be provided to those employees whose employment was terminated on or after 28 September 1, 2008, and prior to February 17, 2009, in accordance with Section 3001 of the Act; 29 b. Notification shall be provided to those employees whose employment was terminated on or after 30 February 17, 2009, and prior to the date of enactment of this section, no later than 60 days following 31 the date of enactment of this section or the employee's termination, whichever is later; and c. Notification shall be provided to those employees whose employment was terminated after the date 32 33 of enactment of this section no later than 30 days following the date of the employee's termination; 34 4. The employee shall elect this continued coverage no later than 60 days following notification of 35 plan enrollment options; and 36 5. All other provisions, restrictions and limitations contained in the Act shall apply. 37 B. The provisions of this section shall only apply to employees of small employers whose group 38 health insurance coverage does not provide for continuation of coverage under the Consolidated 39 Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 (COBRA). C. As used in this section, "group health insurance coverage" and "health insurance issuer" shall have 40 41 the same meaning as provided in § 38.2-3431.

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
