A BILL to amend and reenact § 25.1-235 of the Code of Virginia, relating to compensation of condemnation jurors.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 25.1-235 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 25.1-235. Compensation of jurors.

The jurors ~~empanelled~~ *summoned* shall, for every day or portion thereof they may be employed in the performance of their duties, receive an allowance in the amount of ~~\$60 prescribed in §17.1-618~~ as compensation for their attendance, travel and other costs, ~~regardless of the number of cases heard on any particular day~~, to be paid by the petitioner. ~~The persons summoned who appear, but are not empanelled to serve as jurors, shall be allowed \$30 for each day they are summoned to appear.~~
