10	WHEREAS, the Virginia Indigent Defense Commission provides legal representation for indigents
11	accused of crimes; and
12	WHEREAS, Virginia has been ranked among the lowest in the nation by the ABA in terms of
13	compensation for court appointed-counsel; and
14	WHEREAS, this lack of adequate compensation has its greatest impact on those counties not served
15 16	by the Indigent Defense Commission; and WILEDEAS in Montagement County original agent make up more than 66 percent of agent
10	WHEREAS, in Montgomery County, criminal cases make up more than 66 percent of cases commenced in the circuit court; and
	WHEREAS, unlike some other localities in the 27th Circuit, Montgomery's population has increased
19	nearly 10 percent in the last decade and case filings increased more than 22 percent between 2007 and
20	2008; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Virginia Indigent Defense
22	Commission be requested to study the creation of a public defender office to serve Montgomery County.
<u>23</u>	In conducting its study, the Commission shall consider the County's criminal caseload, projected
24	population growth, and the current level of service provided by court-appointed counsel.
25	Technical assistance shall be provided to the Commission by the Executive Secretary of the Virginia
26	Supreme Court, if necessary. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the
27	Commission for this study, upon request.
28	The Commission shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2010, and shall submit to the
29 20	Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report of its findings and
30 31	recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for
21	shan be submitted as provided in the proceedines of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for

32 the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of the 2011 Regular33 Session of the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website.
