7 Connections, The Capital Area Agency on Aging (CAAA), is recognized in 2010 for his advocacy on

 10 Empty Plate Luncheon, which is Senior Connections CAAA's largest fundraiser; and

WHEREAS, through the hard work of Harris Spindle, staff, and enthusiastic volunteers, the Empty Plate Luncheon is annually held in the fall and is sponsored by the Science Museum of Virginia; it attracts between 300 and 400 attendees and results in greatly needed funds from individual ticket sales and generous corporate sponsors; and

 population on the local level, as well as during the General Assembly session; and

WHEREAS, Harris Spindle works closely with civic and nonprofit entities, state agencies, and
