SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 265

Offered March 8, 2010

Commending pregnancy care centers. 4

Patrons-Vogel, Barker, Hanger, Martin, McDougle, McWaters, Newman, Obenshain and Quayle

WHEREAS, the life-affirming impact of pregnancy care centers on the women, men, children, and communities they serve is considerable and growing; and

8 WHEREAS, pregnancy care centers serve women in Virginia and across the United States with 9 integrity and compassion; and

10 WHEREAS, more than 30 pregnancy care centers across Virginia provide comprehensive care to women and men facing unplanned pregnancies, including resources to meet their physical, psychological, 11 emotional, and spiritual needs; and 12

13 WHEREAS, last year alone, pregnancy care centers provided free, confidential help and services to 14 over 19,000 women in Virginia, including 9,200 free pregnancy tests, 9,600 free packs of diapers, 8,000 free bags of baby clothes, 3,800 free classes on topics ranging from infant care and parenting to job 15 16 search skills, and 2,800 limited ultrasounds; and

WHEREAS, these and other services amounted to approximately \$1.1 million in services and goods 17 18 to women and families; and

19 WHEREAS, pregnancy care centers offer women free, confidential, and compassionate services, 20 including pregnancy tests, peer counseling, 24-hour telephone hotlines, childbirth and parenting classes, 21 and referrals to community, health care, and other support services; and 22

WHEREAS, many medical pregnancy care centers offer ultrasounds and other medical services; and

23 WHEREAS, many pregnancy care centers provide information on adoption and adoption referrals to 24 pregnant women; and

25 WHEREAS, pregnancy care centers encourage women to make positive life choices by equipping them with complete and accurate information regarding their pregnancy options and the development of 26 27 their unborn children; and 28

WHEREAS, pregnancy care centers provide women with compassionate and confidential peer counseling in a nonjudgmental manner regardless of their pregnancy outcomes; and

30 WHEREAS, pregnancy care centers provide important support and resources for women who choose 31 childbirth over abortion; and 32

WHEREAS, pregnancy care centers ensure that women are receiving prenatal information and services that lead to the birth of healthy infants; and

WHEREAS, many pregnancy care centers provide grief assistance for women and men who regret the loss of their child from past choices they have made; and

WHEREAS, many pregnancy care centers work to prevent unplanned pregnancies by teaching effective abstinence education in public schools; and

38 WHEREAS, pregnancy care centers operate primarily through reliance on the voluntary donations 39 and time of caring individuals who are committed to caring for the needs of women and promoting and 40 protecting life; now, therefore, be it

41 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend pregnancy care centers for their outstanding service to women in Virginia; and, be it 42

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for 43 presentation to the pregnancy care centers as an expression of the General Assembly's admiration and 44 gratitude for the work of the centers. 45
