Summary:** Provides for the delayed implementation of some statutes and regulations upon which the accreditation of schools in the Commonwealth is based that were not already in effect on June 30, 2008, until July 1, 2011, unless such statutes or regulations are also specifically required by federal code, federal regulation, or court action.

- **8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation delays implementation of some statutes or regulations prescribing additional requirements for graduation or accreditation of schools until July 1, 2011 (fiscal year 2012), unless such statutes or regulations are required by federal code, federal regulation, or court action. It is presumed that by delaying the implementation of any such statutes and regulations, divisions will not incur any additional expense related to such measures in fiscal year 2011. However, given the impact of any such statutes and regulations will vary by division, it is not possible to accurately estimate the potential local savings attributed to the deferral. This legislation is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.
