4. Title: State Board of Elections; voter lists.

5. Summary: Expands the list of people and organizations who may purchase the list of registered voters and list of persons who voted in elections.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: There is no fiscal impact.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill should not have a fiscal impact on State Board of Elections (SBE) because the agency can recover its costs from producing lists. The current charge for a statewide list is about \$5,000. Pricing is based on the number of registered voters and not on the content of the list. No separate charge is made for voter history data. The price is designed to recover costs and SBE does not profit from sales of list.
