**4. Title:** Elections; distribution of mail voter registration application forms.

**5. Summary:** Provides that the State Board of Elections (SBE), in cooperation with the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries, will make mail voter registration application forms available where hunting licenses are sold.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate fiscal impact.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** Yes, HB30, Item 79

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The enactment of this bill will increase the demand for voter registration applications, thereby resulting in increased expenditures for SBE, associated with the printing and distribution of said applications. Under current statute, it is discretionary for SBE to provide applications to the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF). Therefore, demand for voter applications from DGIF has been minimum. DGIF will absorb any costs associated with increased workload.
