**4. Title:**            Establish civil penalty for smoking in a motor vehicle with a minor present.

**5. Summary:** This bill provides a civil penalty of \$100 for anyone who smokes in a motor vehicle, whether in motion or at rest, in which a child under the age of 13 is present.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate (see Section 8)

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Currently, there is insufficient information available to reliably estimate how many violations could result from this proposed legislation. Resulting fines would be paid into the Virginia Health Care Fund. Normally, civil penalties collected under these provisions would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
