- **5.** Summary: This legislation delays implementation of any statutes or regulations prescribing additional requirements for graduation until July 1, 2011 (fiscal year 2012), unless such statutes or regulations are required by federal code, federal regulation, or court action.

- 7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: It is presumed that by delaying the implementation of any such statutes and regulations, divisions will not incur any additional expense related to such measures in fiscal year 2011. However, given the impact of any such statutes and regulations will vary by division, it is not possible to accurately estimate the potential local savings attributed to the deferral. This legislation is not expected to have state fiscal impact.
