8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Bristol Drug Court application, the proposed startup budget to operate the court is \$137,000. The funding to operate this drug court was donated by the Commonwealth's Attorney's office with the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, intensive case management, supervision and program coordination to 16 to 19 participants per year. In addition, the Bristol Drug Treatment Court is applying for currently open federal grant solicitations due February 11, 2010. Also, the Court is working with Occupational Enterprises, Inc. (a local non-profit) who received a \$1 million Substance Abuse Group for Education (SAGE) grant; it is anticipated the Bristol Drug Court could be eligible for up to \$100,000 of this funding.
