3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: Industrialized Building Safety Law

5. Summary: Provides that any person aggrieved by the Department of Housing and Community Development's application of the Industrialized Building Safety Law appeal to the State Building Code Technical Review Board. Currently only local building officials, compliance assurance agencies, and industrialized building manufacturers are listed as being allowed such appeals. In addition, the bill deletes references to model code writing entities and replaces them with the International Code Council.

6. No fiscal impact.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: None.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Housing and Community Development.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: Yes. Line 22, after "Council" strike "," and insert "and". Line 23, strike "and the Council of American Building Officials". The ICC has absorbed the applicable responsibilities of the Council of American Building Officials and the reference to the council is not longer necessary as it no longer exists.
