3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: **Freedom of Information Act; Exemption for credit card and bank account data.**

5. Summary: The bill exempts from the mandatory disclosure provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, those portions of records that contain account numbers or routing information for any credit card, debit card, or other account with a financial institution of any person or public body. The bill provides, however, that access shall not be denied to the person who is the subject of the record. The bill defines “financial institution” and contains an emergency clause.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: The impacts are indeterminate as there may be state agency applications or systems that require modification to follow these new requirements.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Any state agency or political subdivision with records containing account numbers or routing information.
