4. Title: Jordan River; designates portion thereof as component of State Scenic Rivers System

5. Summary: This bill designates a portion of the Jordan River, approximately six miles, as a component of the Virginia Scenic Rivers System.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: Studies related to this designation have already been completed by the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), which is tasked with oversight of these designations. The agency anticipates being able to absorb any additional costs resulting from this bill.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: The Department of Conservation and Recreation.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: Other bills that seek to designate portions of rivers as being components of the Virginia Scenic Rivers System, are: SB17 (Blackwater River), SB94 (Blackwater River), and HB503 (Hughes River).
